


# TEAM RED



# CRAFTY CORNER

## MOTHER'S DAY FLOWERS

You will need:  
 Coloured card or paper  
 Sellotape or glue  
 Scissors  
 Straws



1. Take a piece of coloured paper or card that measures about 30cm by 15cm. Fold the short edge over 1cm, turn it over and repeat so you create a concertina.

2. Pull the short edges round and fix them to each other with sellotape. This is your flower head.



3. Cut a small card or paper circle and stick it to the centre of your flower.

4. Finally, fix a straw to the back of the flower to make a stem.

Why not head outside this March on a windy day and fly a kite! You could even have a go at making your own kite.




Can you spot the catkins on the trees? They are little clusters of flowers hanging down from the tree branches that allow the trees to be pollinated.




St Patrick's Day is on Wednesday 17th March so why not head out to the garden and see if you can spot a 4 leaf clover.

# EASTER EGG...


It's not long until Easter! Can you name all the birds below that lay eggs. You can meet them all on our Farm Trail when we re-open.


